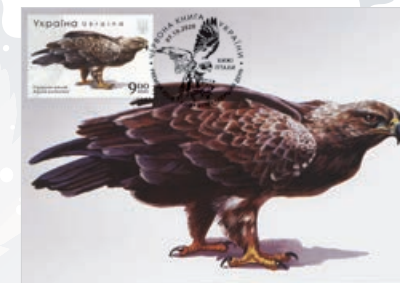

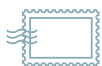
Birds of prey are birds that prey in flight using their effective senses, especially sight. In general, they have large claws and beaks adapted to capture the victim.

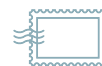
ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Formation of a separate detachment of Sich Riflemen began its journey with the Halytsko-Bukovinian hut, which was established in Kyiv in the autumn of 1917 from Ukrainians, former soldiers of the Austro-Hungarian army. Subsequently renamed in the hut of the Sich Riflemen, and later successively deployed in the regiment, a separate detachment and in Sich Riflemen Corps. Yevhen Konovalets was the permanent Sich Riflemen's team commander.

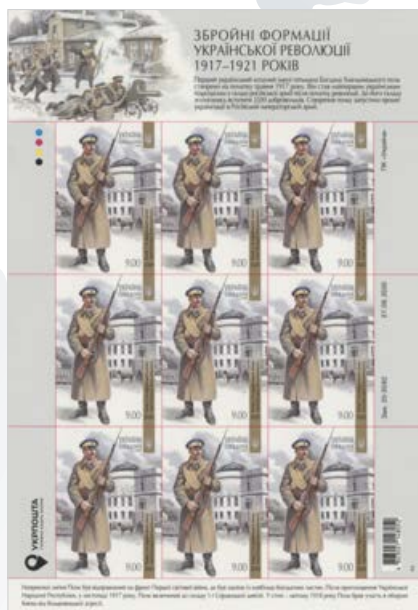

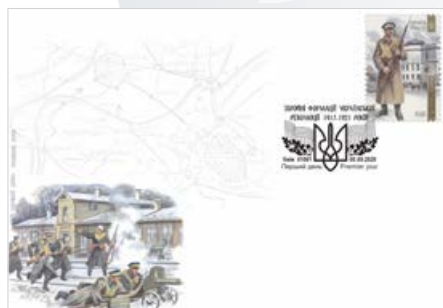

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

An ancient ornament is dukach (lychman, yag-nus) - Ukrainian ornament in the form of a large medal-shaped coin with a metal bow, adjacent to solved stones. Dukach served as a certain compositional center of all women's breast ornaments and was fixed on the most prominent part of the necklace. As a rule, it was made of coins, and its history dates back to the Cossacks.

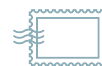

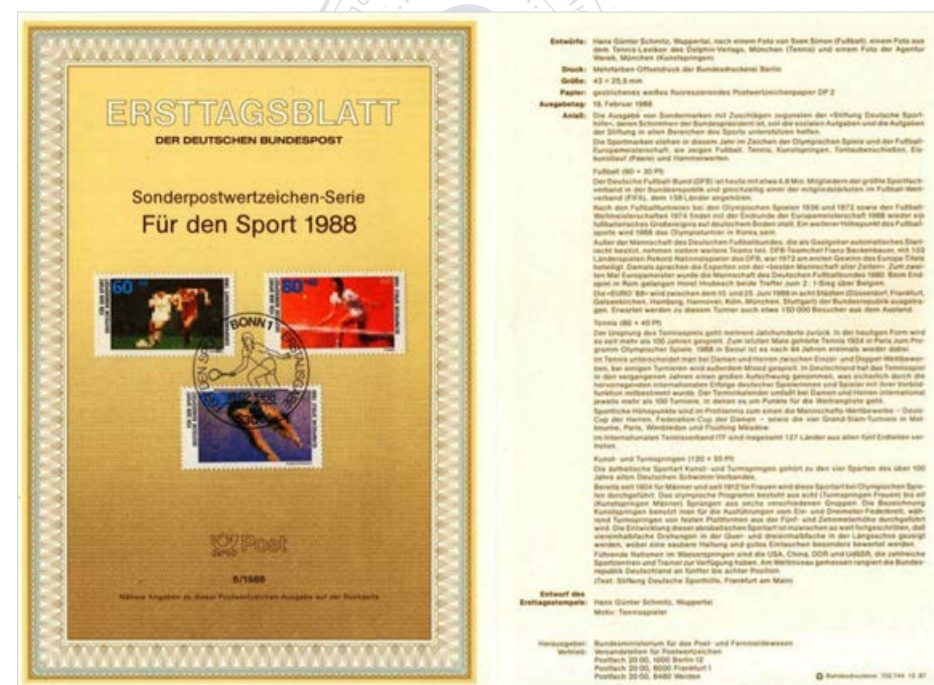


FIRST PRESENTATION SHEETS OF POSTAGE STAMPS OF UKRAINE

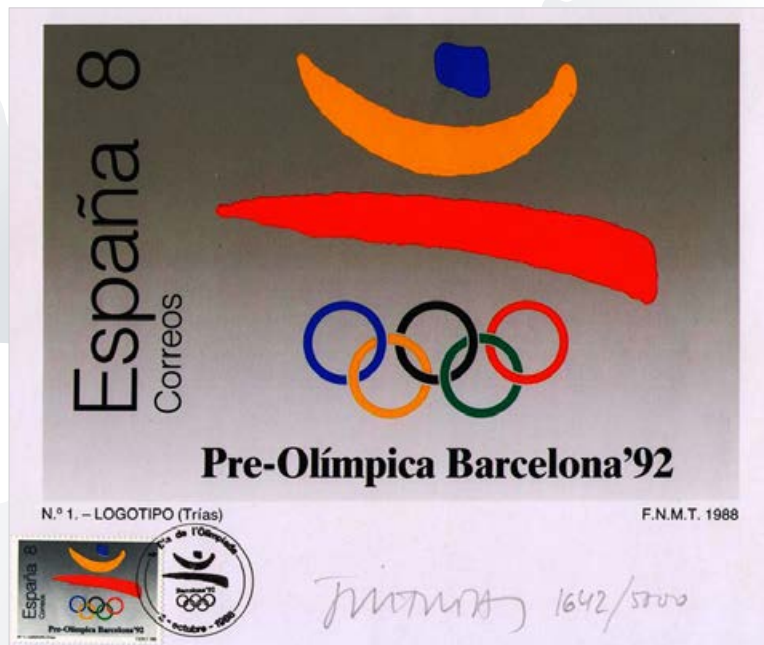
It is well known that the expression "First day" means the day of introduction of postage stamps (series), block or postal stationery. This sentence also implies several concepts, such as First Day stamps, First Day envelopes, postal stationery of the First Day. However, the phrase "First Day" has another unusual meaning for us - the so-called letters of the First Day.

For almost three decades, post offices in many countries around the world have been issuing such letters specifically for the release of new postage stamps. They did not receive an official philatelic term, so each country has its own names: letters of cancellation, letters of the First Day, and so on.

These letters are stamped with postage stamps or blocks, which are canceled with the postmark of the First Day and their basic philatelic data are printed. But the letters do not have specific international requirements for their design, content and printing. Therefore, they are printed in various formats in the form of single or double letters, with artistic drawings, with the image of various emblems and logos, with embossed paper, with propaganda texts and slogans, which are dedicated to the postage stamp (block) and displayed events on it.

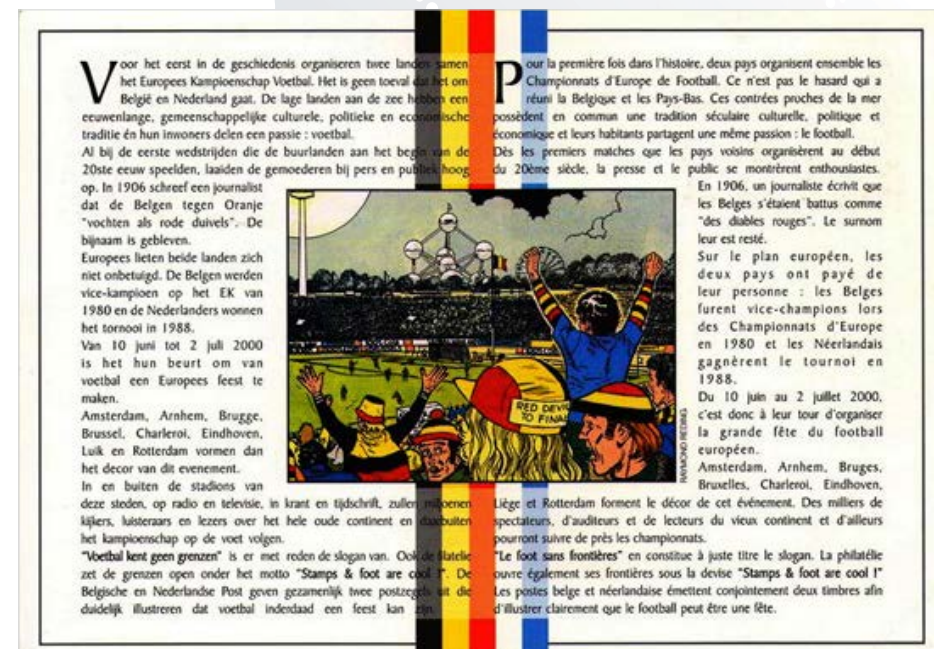
Single sheet with the image of the logo

The front side of a single cancellation sheet



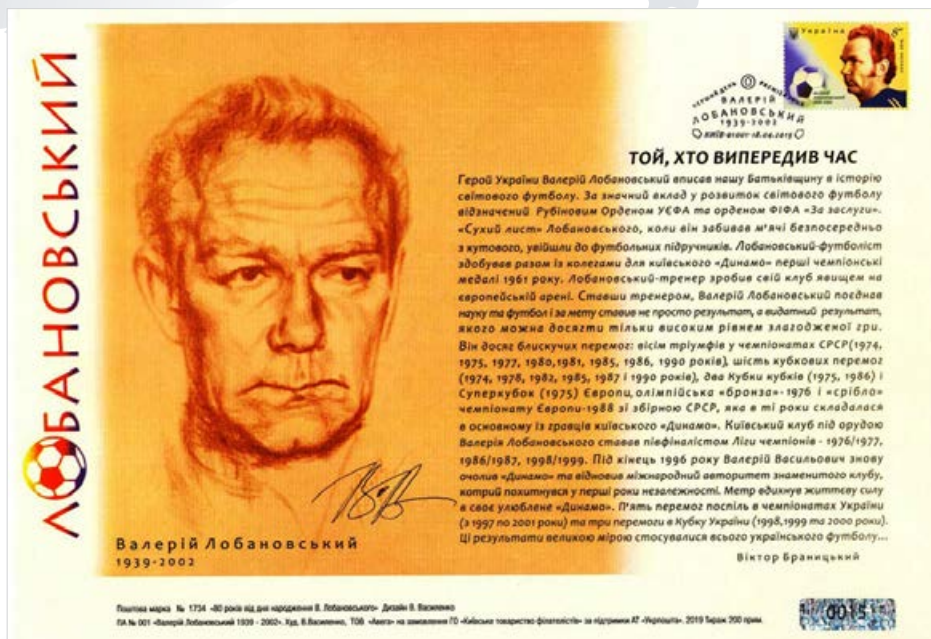

By their purpose, cancellation letters perform several functions, namely:

- confirm the first day of introduction of postage stamps;
- help to promote new issues of postage stamps and blocks;
- is the subject of philatelic collecting.

Therefore, to mark the day of the introduction of a new domestic postage stamp (block) and its cancellation with the stamp "First Day" a few years later, such letters appeared in Ukraine. Thanks to the opportunity to present new postage stamps, they received the name "Presentation Sheet" from philatelists. The initiator of the first presentation sheet was the Kyiv Society of Philatelists of AsPhU (KTF). This sheet was dedicated to the postage stamp №1734 "Valerii Lobanovskiy. 1939-2002".

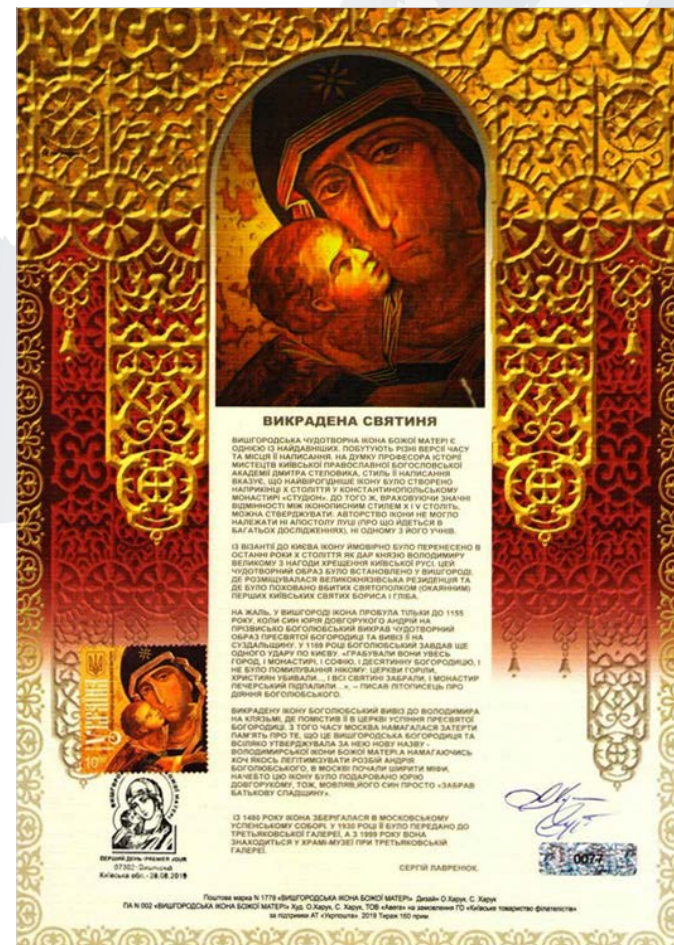
The sheet shows the image as close as possible to the image of the postage stamp. The author of the drawing is a well-known artist in philately Vasyl Vasilenko. The postage stamp is pasted on the most attractive place of the presentation sheet and canceled with the stamp "First day".



The presentation sheet has a concise text about the event, a real facsimile of the artist, protection in the form of a hologram with a copy number, and the bottom field of the sheet shows the basic philatelic and publishing data.

Taking into account the interest shown by philatelists not only in Ukraine but also in other countries to issue the first presentation sheet, the Kyiv Society of Philatelists on August 28, 2019 issued the second sheet of postage stamp №1778 "Vyshhorod Icon of the Mother of God". It is worth noting that the wonderful decoration of the sheet was created by talented artists - brothers Oleksandr and Serhii Haruk.

By the way, the Haruks brothers are the authors of the original issue of holographic stamps "Insects of Ukraine", which won philatelic Olympic gold - the Grand Prix of the international competition for the best stamp of 2018 WIPA (Vienna, Austria).



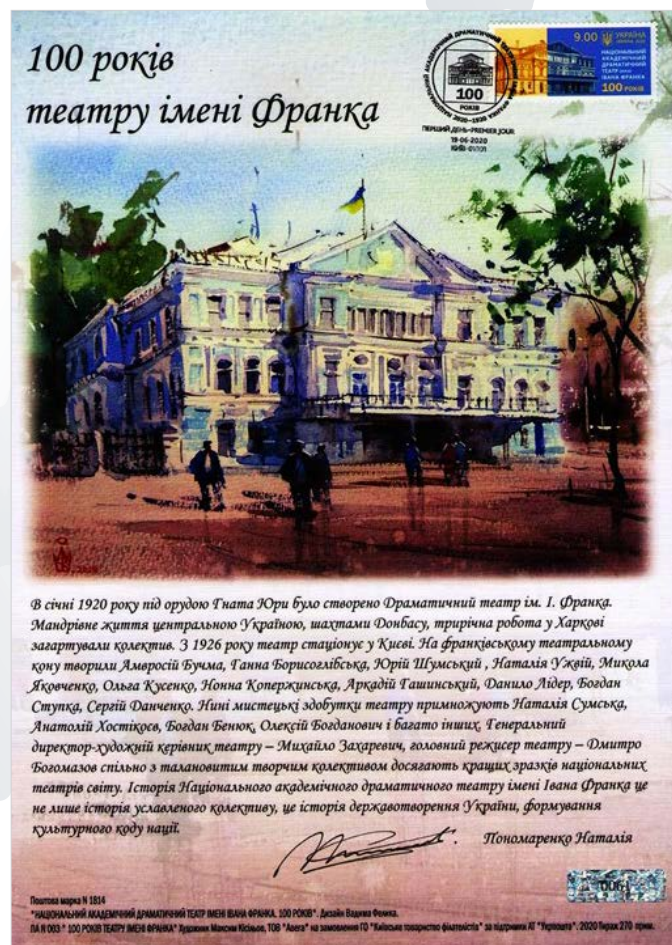
Unusual philatelic material, original cancellation of the postage stamp with the First Day postmark, author's artistic drawing - all this gave the presentation sheet the opportunity to present the new postage stamp "Vyshhorod Icon of the Mother of God" on the day of its introduction.

The celebrations took place in the Cathedral of the Vyshhorod Mother of God of the Kyiv Archdiocese of the UGCC in Vyshhorod in the presence of its pilgrims, clergy, officials of the Ukrposhta Philatelic Products Department, heads of local authorities, cultural figures, representatives of the Kyiv Philatelic Society and various members. regions of the country.

All copies of the presentation sheets were successfully distributed among the collections of customers, philatelists of Ukraine and abroad, as well as among clergy and pilgrims.

June 19, the day of the introduction of the postage stamp № 1814 "National Academic Drama Theater named after Ivan Franko. 100 years" Kyiv Society of Philatelists of AsPhU released the third presentation sheet. At the request of KTF, a young, talented, Ukrainian artist Maksym Kisilyov painted the watercolor "Ivan Franko Theater" in his own manner, which was used to decorate the presentation sheet.

The presentation sheet "100 years of the Franko Theater", like its predecessors, was a success among collectors in Ukraine and abroad.



According to Maksym Kisilyov's drawings, SC Ukrposhta has already issued a stamped decorative envelope "Lviv Press" (Order T-0259.07.2018), a decorative postage stamp №1804 "Maksym Kisilyov. Before the rain. Lviv", maximumcard №157 "M. Kisilev. Lviv". In August, before the anniversary date of the theater and the

solemn special cancellation, the post office in cooperation with the Kyiv Society of Philatelists of AsPhU issued an pre-stamped decorative envelope (DL) "Theater. I. Franko, Kyiv" with a watercolor drawing by the artist M. Kisilyov.



We hope that the presentation sheets will provide an opportunity for philatelists to diversify their collections.

PHILATELY NEWS

"Ukrfilex 2020" is a large-scale philatelic event in Ukraine

The 18th National Philatelic Exhibition "Ukrfilex 2020", dedicated to the 30th anniversary of the Declaration of State Sovereignty of Ukraine, took place on September 10-13 in Kharkiv at the Kharkiv Regional Philharmonic. The large-scale philatelic vernissage was organized by the Association of Philatelists of Ukraine with the support of Ukrposhta under the patronage of the Kharkiv mayor.

National philatelic exhibitions take place in Ukraine every two years. Ivano-Frankivsk, Lviv, Cherkasy, Sevastopol, Donetsk, Dnipro, Odesa, Chernivtsi, Kyiv had the honor of hosting the National Philatelic Exhibitions. But Kharkiv is hosting Ukrfilex for the first time since the days of independent Ukraine.

This year, 112 collectors from Ukraine and abroad presented 128 philatelic exhibits at the exhibition. Some exhibits won gold medals at European and world international exhibitions in New York, Yokohama, London, Jakarta and others.

Every day of the vernissage was filled with philatelic events: special cancellations, presentations, master classes, meetings with artists and philatelists.

To commemorate the opening of "Ukrfilex 2020", Ukrposhta issued an envelope of the same name with the original stamp. The envelope depicts the building of the Philharmonic - the venue of the exhibition, the monument to Taras Shevchenko, the panorama of the city; on the postage stamp - the logo of the exhibition. The special envelope cancellation ceremony took place on September, 10 with the participation of Ukrposhta Director General Igor Smelyansky, Kharkiv Deputy Mayor Svitlana Gorbunova-Ruban, Exhibition Organizing Committee Chairman Vitalii Katsman and Kharkiv Regional Philharmonic Director Yuri Yanko.

Igor Smelyansky, Ukrposhta Director General:

"For the first time in 42 years, Kharkiv is hosting a philatelic exhibition. Ukrposhta has prepared a number of new issues and special cancellations for this significant event among connoisseurs of postal miniatures. Philatelists and visitors of the exhibition will be the first to see the marked products that will be presented at the exhibition: the postage block of the series "Cultural Epochs of Ukraine. Scythians" and the final stamp sheet of the series "Ukrainian alphabet".

I hope that they will take a prominent place in the collections of philatelists and will be appreciated by collectors around the world. Everyone who visits the exhibition will be able to see unique postal miniatures and purchase new postal issues. And Ukrposhta will continue to amaze with new original plots, collaborate with contemporary artists and use new ideas to make postal miniature as a separate art form interesting for collectors, young people and those who are getting acquainted with philately for the first time."

On September 11, a special cancellation and introduction of a new postage block from the series "Cultural Epochs of Ukraine. Scythians", which consists of two stamps took place:

"The battle of the Scythians with the army of the Macedonians in 339 BC. is." and "The Battle of the Scythians against Zopyrion - the military leader O. of

Macedon 331 BC. is.". The fields of the block are artistically decorated: the central figures are two Scythian archers in full armor, who, pulling the bowstring, are ready to fire arrows from the bows.

The block depicts gold Scythian ornaments found on the territory of Ukraine and contains an inscription: "The Scythian period of Ukrainian history begins in the second half of the VII century. BC and ends in the second century BC". The block and envelope "First Day" presents exhibits of the Museum of Historical Treasures of Ukraine.

Circulation of the block "Cultural epochs of Ukraine. Scythians" - 20 thousand copies. A souvenir booklet has been issued for the postage block.

The series "Cultural Epochs of Ukraine" was launched in 2017 and began with the release of "Paleolithic". Two years ago, the Trypillia block was put into circulation, and in 2019 - the Cimmerians. The authors of the series are Ukrainian graphic artists Oleksandr and Serhiy Haruk.

On September 12, the presentation and special cancellation of the final stamp sheet of the Ukrainian Alphabet series, started in 2018, took place. Kost Lavro, a well-known Ukrainian artist, winner of the Taras Shevchenko National Prize of Ukraine, worked on the sketches of the stamps. The issue of "Ukrainian Alphabet" crowns the issue of the presentation booklet of the same name, which contains all three stamp sheets of the series and is decorated with children's poems by Oksana Krotyuk.

The Ukrainian Alphabet stamps are an ideal opportunity to introduce children to philately, so it is only natural that they arouse the interest of young visitors to the exhibition.

On the final day of the film exhibition, September 13, the jury determined the best exhibits that will represent Ukraine at international philatelic exhibitions. The Grand Prix of the exhibition was won by the collection of Yosyp Lyubinin, the National Grand Prix - the collection of Andrii Hrodetskyi.

"Ukrfilex 2020" also hosted meetings with Kharkiv artists: Nikita Titov, illustrator, author of the "Peredova" stamp, which is a sign of gratitude to thousands of medics and the military for devotion, courage and professionalism, and Artem Suprun, whose work "View to the Intercession Monastery" became a sketch of a stamp decorative envelope issued in honor of the exhibition.

Every day philatelists and guests of the exhibition hunted for new issues and new special cancellations of Ukrposhta. All visitors had a memory of the large-scale philatelic event by unique postal miniatures, as well as many vivid emotions and impressions.

Another victory of Ukrainian postage stamps!

The bronze of the Yehudi Menuhin Trophy 2020 competition for the best music postage stamp of the world in 2019 was won by the Ukrainian postage stamp "Oleksandr Vertynskyi. 1889–1957" by Vasyl Vasylenko, winning 180 votes.

Prize named after Yehuda Menuhin - an award of the International Philatelic Association Philatelic Music Circle (PMC), which dates back to 2001.

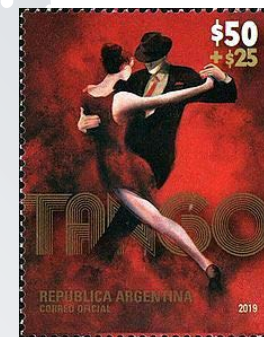
The award is given to artists for the best postage stamp of the previous year on music. The award was established in honor of the American violinist and conductor Yehudi Menuhin (1916-1999).

This year 66 stamps from 44 postal administrations took part in the Competition. Collectors from 58 countries from 5 continents took part in the online voting.



The first place, with 220 votes, was won by the stamp of the Argentine Republic "Tango".

The second place, with 197 votes, went to the stamp dedicated to the founding of Chilean children's and youth orchestras.

Ukrposhta has issued unique flavored postage stamps

On July 15, 2020, the postage stamps "Garden Jasmine" and "Lavender" were introduced. The Garden Flowers series is truly unique. The brands "Garden Jasmine" and "Lavender" have an unusual format - round, and they are printed on self-adhesive paper. Flavored paper adds a special charm to postage stamps: lightly rubbing the stamps, you will feel the aroma of jasmine and lavender.

Ukrposhta firstly produced flavored stamps in 2004. Then with the aroma of pine needles were issued postage stamps "Happy New Year! Happy New Happiness!" authored by Maria Heiko. Sketches of postal products of the series "Garden Flowers" were developed by Natalia Kohal, a member of the National Union of Artists of Ukraine, author of many postage stamps, including "White Stork" and "Oriental Nightingale", which won first place in the competition "Europe's Best Stamp - Collector's Choice 2019".

The circulation of each postage stamp is 100 thousand copies, and the face value is 13.50 hryvnias. This is the tariff for sending a simple letter weighing from 50 to 250 grams within Ukraine.

The solemn ceremony of special redemption/cancellation of the postage stamp took place on July, 15 at 12:00 in Kyiv at the Botanical Garden named after Academician Oleksandr Fomin. The event was attended by young artists - students of the Kyiv Children's Creativity Center KEVIN kids, as well as the Director General of Ukrposhta Igor Smelyansky.

Meeting of the Editorial and Art Council on the Issue of Postage Stamps, Stamped Envelopes and Cards in Ukraine

On July 14 and September 30, 2020, meetings of the Editorial and Art Council on the Issue of Postage Stamps, stamped envelopes and cards in Ukraine (Rada) took place, at which members of the Council considered appeals for additional issues of postage stamps, envelopes and special cancellations.

At the meetings, sketches for stamps, envelopes, stamps of special cancellations for 2020-2021 were approved and a number of decisions were made on the issue of postal products in 2020-2021:

2020:

- issue of a postage stamp with the characters of the cartoon "Cossacks";
- issue of decorative unstamped envelope C5 with the work "I went, boys, to sleep" of the children's drawing contest "Just Fiction";
- holding a special cancellation dedicated to the 350th anniversary of the birth of Samiilo Velychko;
- holding a special cancellation dedicated to the 75th anniversary of the founding of Uzhhorod National University;
- holding a special cancellation dedicated to the 100th anniversary of the birth of Mykola Radeiko;
- holding a special cancellation dedicated to the 115th anniversary of the opening of the Chernivtsi Academic Regional Ukrainian Music and Drama Theater named after Olha Kobylyanska;
- holding a special cancellation dedicated to the 60th anniversary of the building of the National Circus of Ukraine;
- producing a postmark with the transfer date "Chernihiv - the city of legends";

2021:

- issue of postage stamp of the joint issue Ukraine - Israel on the topic "Nobel Prize winners. Shmuel Joseph Agnon";
- issue of postage stamp dedicated to the 100th anniversary of the first Ukrainian tractor "Zaporozhets";
- issue of postage stamp dedicated to the 35th anniversary of the Chornobyl tragedy;
- issue of postal envelope dedicated to the opening of the first garrison church in Ukraine (Lviv);
- issue of a postal envelope and special cancellation dedicated to the 130th anniversary of the birth of Sergei Prokofiev;
- issue of a postal envelope and special cancellation dedicated to the National Team of Veterans of Ukraine. Games of the Unconquered in The Hague;
- issue of a postal envelope dedicated to the 875th anniversary of the first written mention of the city of Medzhibizh;
- issue of a general envelope dedicated to the anniversaries of educational institutions;
- holding special cancellations "First Day", dedicated to the 100th anniversary of the Second Winter Campaign of the UPR Army in Kyiv, Vinnytsia, Zhytomyr;
- holding special cancellation dedicated to Vinnytsia Medical College named after D. Zabolotny;

- holding special cancellation dedicated to the 100th anniversary of the founding of the University of the State Fiscal Service of Ukraine;
- holding a special cancellation dedicated to the 100th anniversary of the Kharkiv National University of Pharmacy;
- producing a postmark with the transfer date "State Historical and Architectural Reserve in Berezhany".

At the same time, due to problems with Ukrposhta's compliance with the Law of Ukraine "On Copyright and Related Rights", the Council decided to cancel in 2020 the issue of a postal envelope dedicated to the 170th anniversary of R. Sudkovsky's birth.

NEW-OLD philatelic products from Ukrposhta

Despite the variety of forms and plots of Ukrainian postage stamps, it is not an easy task to surprise a domestic philatelist with something new.

In different years, Ukrposhta experimented with new forms of philatelic products that would both contain zest and leave no doubt about the official nature of their origin.

Beginning in 2001, the Marka Ukrainy Directorate began issuing uncut printed sheets. Issues lasted until 2009. After a long break, Ukrposhta, at the initiative of philatelists, resumed the issue of uncut printed sheets, changing the approaches to their distribution.

In order to organize a transparent process of accepting pre orders for such issues, Ukrposhta invited the Association of Philatelists of Ukraine to cooperate.

Basic rules:

1. Full members of AsPhU who have a current philatelic subscription to SC Ukrposhta, who have been purchased all ordered philatelic production, may apply for the purchase of the above-mentioned uncut sheets.
2. Collection of applications begins from the date of official publication of the announcement of the planned issue on the websites of Ukrposhta and AsPhU.
3. The list is formed in the order of chronology of applications. After typing the required number of applications, the pre-order is terminated, about which information is posted on these sites.
4. You can buy the ordered products in the philatelic shops of Kyiv within 2 months from the date of putting into circulation (receipt for sale) of the above-mentioned postal issues, provided that you present an identity card.
5. Philatelists from other regions can receive the sheet either independently or through an authorized person.
6. In case of non-purchase of the ordered products within the term specified in item 4 it is realized in free sale.

The book presents and describes in Ukrainian and English postage stamps and blocks issued in 2019.

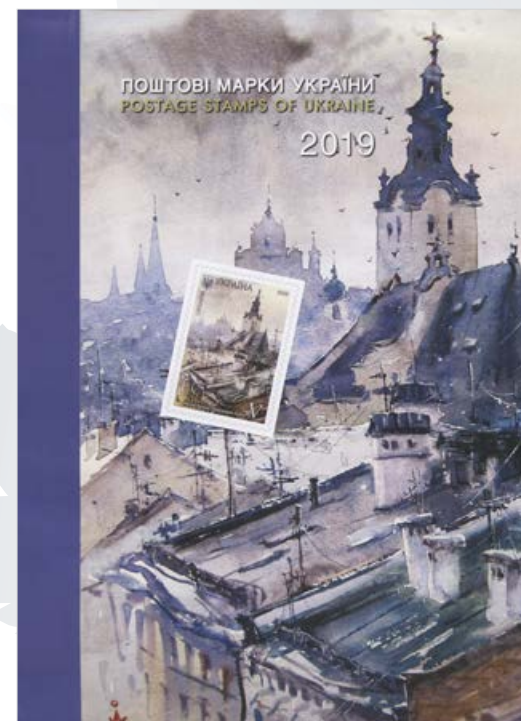
The cover uses the work of a young and promising artist Maxim Kisilev "Before the rain. Lviv" according to the sketch of the postage stamp of the same name.

The whole world celebrates the 250th anniversary of the birth of Ludwig Beethoven

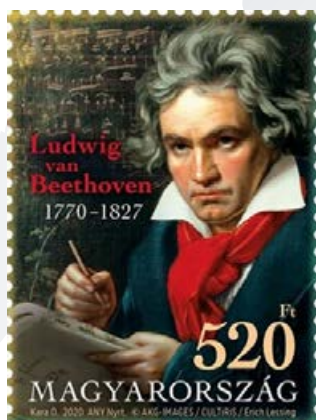
